1. Product description

KEIM Putzgrund is a siliceous base coating with a rough surface and good filling and covering properties.

2. Field of application

KEIM Putzgrund is suitable for interior and exterior application. KEIM Putzgrund serves as a base coat for KEIM Brillantputz on old and new plasters of mortar groups PII und PIII and on gypsum plasters and gypsum plasterboards in interiors. KEIM Putzgrund reduces the absorbing capability of the substrate and increases the open time of KEIM Brillantputz. The rough surface with good grip enables optimum processing of KEIM Brillantputz, even on very smooth substrates. Furthermore, KEIM Putzgrund must be used as a primer for KEIM Indusil groove plaster structure to prevent the substrate from shining through.

Substrates

Substrates must be even, sound and dry. Allow new base plasters to harden for at least 14 days!

Application

If required, dilute KEIM Putzgrund with KEIM Spezial-Fixativ (maximum 10%). Apply evenly using a brush or roller.

Application temperature

Not below + 5° C air and substrate temperature

Approx. 0.3 kg/m²

Cleaning of tools

Clean with water immediately after use.

Approx. 12 months if kept cool and frost-free
